






#### **EUROCONTROL** Network




Daily Variation (Flights) compared with equivalent days in 2019





## **COVID-19** sequelae

- COVID-19 positive patients may have sequelae for unknown period of time:
  - Neurologic
  - Respiratory
  - Yascular
  - Sensorial
  - May affect other systems such as
    - Metabolic
    - Renal
    - Mental



#### **COVID-19** positive case assessment

- AME should give more details to the anamnestic interview in regard to respiratory conditions and other medical conditions requiring medical assessment or hospitalisation.
- → In case a history of COVID-19 positivity is found further details should be sought and reviewed. The review should include:
  - clinical data,
  - complementary testing such as Lab testing and image diagnosis
  - treatment provided, including oxygen therapy or assisted ventilation



## **COVID-19** positive case assessment

- Further examinations may be required in order to ensure a reliable aero-medical assessment in terms of organic or functional sequelae of the body systems mentioned previously
- Consideration should be given to evolving knowledge regarding the evolution of the SARS-CoV-2 infection



## **COVID-19** positive case assessment

Several Member States provided guidance material for their AMEs to consider during their medical assessments

 Applicants are free to travel to any Member State to undergo medical examinations – harmonised approach would help to ensure a similar level of safety.

#### **COVID-19** impact

- Reduced number of flights
